Long Point Improvement Association Board of Governors


The Nominations Committee of the Long Point Improvement Association is calling for nominees for the upcoming Board of Governors election. The elections will be held on and leading up to the General Membership meeting on September 13, 2022. If you care about the Long Point community, your property value, and helping to make this the best community in Lake Shore, please consider serving on the Board. Nominees must be able to provide active service this includes attending board meetings and serving on committees. In addition, candidates should also have a strong commitment to the betterment and welfare of our community. A small time commitment goes a long way to helping your community! The requirements for serving on the Board are:

- I- You must be a Long Point resident and/or property owner, and
- 2- You must be a member in good standing of the Long Point Improvement Association.

There are FOUR open Board positions up for election this year. All positions are three year terms, serving December 1, 2022 through November 30, 2025. If you wish to nominate yourself or someone else who meets the requirements stated above, please fill out the form found on the next page and return it to the Nominations Committee by August 31, 2022. New Voting Procedures

The bylaw changes that were approved in 2021 now allow for elections to be conducted electronically. This will allow for greater participation in voting and will easily count votes. LPIA will be conducting the 2022 election through an online process.

Steps for online voting

- I. Only active members of LPIA may vote. If you have not paid dues for 2022, please pay before August 31, 2022.
- 2. Must have an email address registered with LPIA. If you are currently receiving emails from LPIA, then your email is registered. Any members wishing to change their email address must notify the association before August 31, 2022.
- 3. LPIA will use the primary email address associated with the active member to send an electronic ballot. This email address will create a secure ballot that is specific to that property owner. Although your household may have multiple email addresses to receive association information, only one ballot will be sent to your household.
- 4. Online voting will begin on September 7, 2022 and will end at 5pm on September 13, 2022.
- 5. On September 7, 2022 active members will receive an electronic ballot from Election Runner. This is the online service that will be conducting the election. If you do not see the email in your inbox, check your spam folder.
- 6. Members without an email address may request a paper ballot. These will be available after September 7, 2022. Please contact the association and we will get a a ballot to you.
- 7. Results of the election will be announced at the annual meeting on September 13, 2022.


