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

Due to COVID-19, State of Maryland agencies are under a hiring freeze. We therefore have a very limited field staff. We are able to perform very limited laviciding activities. In June we will begin our population and disease monitoring program. Unless the hiring freeze is lifted, ULV fogging for adult mosquitoes will be limited to disease case response and exceptionally high population density of adults to be determined on a case by case basis.

Your Community's assigned spray night is: **Thursday.**

Your community will only ever be fogged on **Thursday** nights during the 2020 season.

Spraying can occur anytime between 7 PM and 2:30 AM.

The spray program will begin on June 3rd. Please stay indoors while spraying operations are being conducted.

October 6 is the estimated last day of spraying for 2020.

Boat Ramp INFORMATION

Due to the Covid-19 stay at home orders in the State of Maryland, the 2020 Boat Ramp registration drive has new dates and new procedures. In order to expedite the process, please carefully read the instructions below.

The 2020 dates and times for registration and key distribution are as follows:

Tuesdays, June 9th, June 16th and June 23rd from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. at the Hall.

We will be practicing precautions in light of COVID-19. For the safety of the Boat Ramp Committee members and your neighbors, please help us by complying.

- •Limit 10 people or less in the Hall at one time
- Everyone will be required to wear a mask
- •Please maintain a 6 foot distance from others in the Hall
- •LPIA will be practicing sanitation practices throughout the registration drive

To obtain a boat ramp key, in addition to your LPIA membership dues and boat ramp dues, you must provide current registrations in your name for trailer(s) and boat(s) at the time of registration. You can submit your membership form and pay membership and boat ramp dues online, but you will still need to show your boat and trailer information in order to be issued your boat ramp key(s).

PLEASE COME PREPARED!

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED: Photo ID with your Long Point address, current boat registration with your Long Point address and your trailer registration. (If you ae able to make copies of these documents, the process will be quicker if you bring those with your originals.) *Part time residents and renters: you must bring a tax or utility bill, or a copy of your lease, listing your address in Long Point.

You will need also to complete a Boater Registration Form and if you haven't, an LPIA Membership Application. Both of these are available using the links below. We encourage you to print these out and have them filled out before you arrive.

PAYMENTS DUE: This year, we are accepting credit cards and checks, **NO CASH**. You may prepay on Paypal (see link below). Please be prepared to pay Membership dues (\$65/ family or \$40/ senior, if you haven't already) and your Boat Ramp dues (\$75 per key, \$25 for additional stickers.)

In review:

•You must be a current member of the Long Point Improvement Association. You may become a member by submitting a membership form and payment on line, by mail, or at the time of Boat Ramp registration. <u>Membership information and the form can be found here.</u>

You may also visit the ShoppingCart on the <u>Membership page</u>. to submit your LPIA membership **and** your boat ramp dues via PayPal.

- •Please plan on stopping by the Hall on one of the 3 Registration dates to complete the registration and key distribution. <u>Download application HERE.</u>
- •You must provide current registration materials for trailer(s), and boat(s) at the time of registration. The boat registrations must belong to a Long Point address and the trailer registration must be in your name **NO EXCEPTIONS**.

The Boat Ramp Committee requests that you make every possible effort to use one of the scheduled dates for registration; the lock will be changed at the end of the final registration drive meeting (June 23, 2020).

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we work through this difficult time.
