### LPIA Property NEWS

This has been a very challenging year for our community and it has had a big impact on income for Long Point. We have, in the past, sold a few very small properties belonging to the community with success— it reduced our expenditures for maintenance of those properties and generated income.

#### **NOTIFICATION OF POTENTIAL PROPERTY SALE**

The board made a decision to look at 3 small properties that are not utilized by members of Long Point and offer them for sale to adjacent neighbors. Per our constitution, we are required to notify the community and to *only* offer the property to adjacent property owners.

This is currently in the process of happening. Properties are between 207 and 211 Circle; 195 and 197 Pike; and 1686 Twickenham and 1688 Sandbar Lane. Two of these properties are a small walkway to Cornfield Creek. The other on Circle is heavily wooded and no water access. We will keep you informed as this progresses.

#### **OTHER NEWS**

Developments on Shoreside Trail and Western Road (paper road) have begun with the sale of 1520 Shoreside Trail. Due to the location of this home, a driveway must be installed to access the property on Western Road, which is owned by the Long Point community. This process has begun, with first submitting drawings to MDE for approval (crossed non-tidal wetlands) and to LPIA (driveway will be using a community lane.) More info will be forthcoming.
